◆*In-School Dual Enrollment*◆

TNCC In-School Dual Enrollment (DE) is a wonderful opportunity for students to earn both college and high school credit for courses taken in their home high schools. **DE is restricted to high school juniors and seniors.** DE students must demonstrate readiness for college, meet college placement testing requirements and course prerequisites, and comply with all other college admission criteria.

Tuition for DE is affordable *The Governor's School covers DE tuition for their students as long as all necessary paperwork is completed and submitted.*

Upon completion of **DE** courses, students are eligible to receive TNCC transcripts.

To get started . . . follow the **DE 3-Step Process** below.

STEP 1 / APPLICATION (*No application fee*) Complete the TNCC application online by going to the TNCC web site www.tncc.edu. Click on *Future Students, Apply Now, New Users*. Write down the **TNCC ID#** you receive for use when you take the placement test (Step 2) and complete the *DE Registration Form* (Step 3).

STEP 2 / TESTING (*No testing fee*) Take the college placement test. A test waiver may be granted (**except for MTH 163 & above, CHM, or PHY**) by submission of a copy of official SAT (*min. area scores/Critical Reading & Math:500*) or ACT (*min. area scores/English & Math:21*) scores prior to DE registration (Fax scores with student name & TNCC ID# to 757.825.3601 or 757.253.4498). For practice, sample test questions are available at www.act.org/compass/sample – and for extra math practice at www.algebasics.com. Students are notified of DE eligibility based on placement test results.

- **DE On-Campus Placement Testing** – Hampton Campus (Griffin Hall) & Historic Triangle Campus (4601 Opportunity Way, Williamsburg).
- No appointment necessary. Except for holidays,
- DE on-campus testing hours are Mon, Tues & Wed/8:00–3:00; Thurs/8:00–5:00; Fri/8:00–10:00. You must bring a photo ID and your TNCC ID# to the test session.
- **DE On-Campus Test Deadlines: Fall 2010 /September 10, 2010; Spring 2011/February 4, 2011.**

IMPORTANT: *GSST Students must take the higher level college Algebra math test*

STEP 3 / REGISTRATION After you have applied and taken the placement test, your Governor's School teacher will provide a *DE Registration Form* during the first week of school.

DE Registration Deadlines: Fall 2010/September 15, 2010; Spring 2011/February 9, 2011.
